I am currently working on the Action Memo for the Wheeling Brake Band Site (the Site) located in Bridgeport, Belmont County, Ohio. To perform this action, EPA will attempt to comply, to the extent practicable, with all Applicable or Relevant and Appropriate Requirements (ARARs) of State environmental and facility siting laws. This email is a request that the State notify the EPA On-Scene Coordinator (OSC) of any State statutes or regulations that the State believes are potential ARARs to the removal site.

EPA will examine these requirements and determine whether they are applicable or relevant and appropriate to the Site. Pursuant to 40 CFR 300.415(j), fund-financed removal actions shall, to the extent practicable considering the exigencies of the situation, attain ARARs under federal environmental or state environmental or facility siting laws.
