Pursuant to N.J.S.A. App. A:9-33 et seq., and in light of Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration regulation 49 C.F.R. Part 390.23(a)(1)(i), which allows for an exemption to the hours of service regulation in 49 C.F.R. Part 395 upon declaration of emergency by the Governor or an authorized representative, the Governor hereby declares an emergency due to Hurricane Irene resulting in the need for emergency removal of waste generated by Hurricane Irene in New Jersey. The emergency is limited to the following:

Type of Operation: Collection and hauling of solid waste debris generated by Hurricane Irene.

Type of Exemption: Restriction of the number of hours that a driver of a commercial motor carrier may drive on duty in 7/8 consecutive days without taking 34 or more consecutive hours off-duty.

Effective Date: August 31, 2011

Termination Date: September 12, 2011

Special Conditions:

- Limited to operators of vehicles involved in the collection or hauling of solid waste within the State of New Jersey.
- Exemption is from the requirements 60/70 hour rule only.
- Drivers must still comply with all other driving regulations.
- No motor carrier operating under the terms of this order shall require or allow a fatigued or ill driver to operate a commercial motor vehicle. A driver who informs a motor carrier that he or she needs immediate rest shall be given a minimum of 10 consecutive off-duty hours before the driver may return to service.
