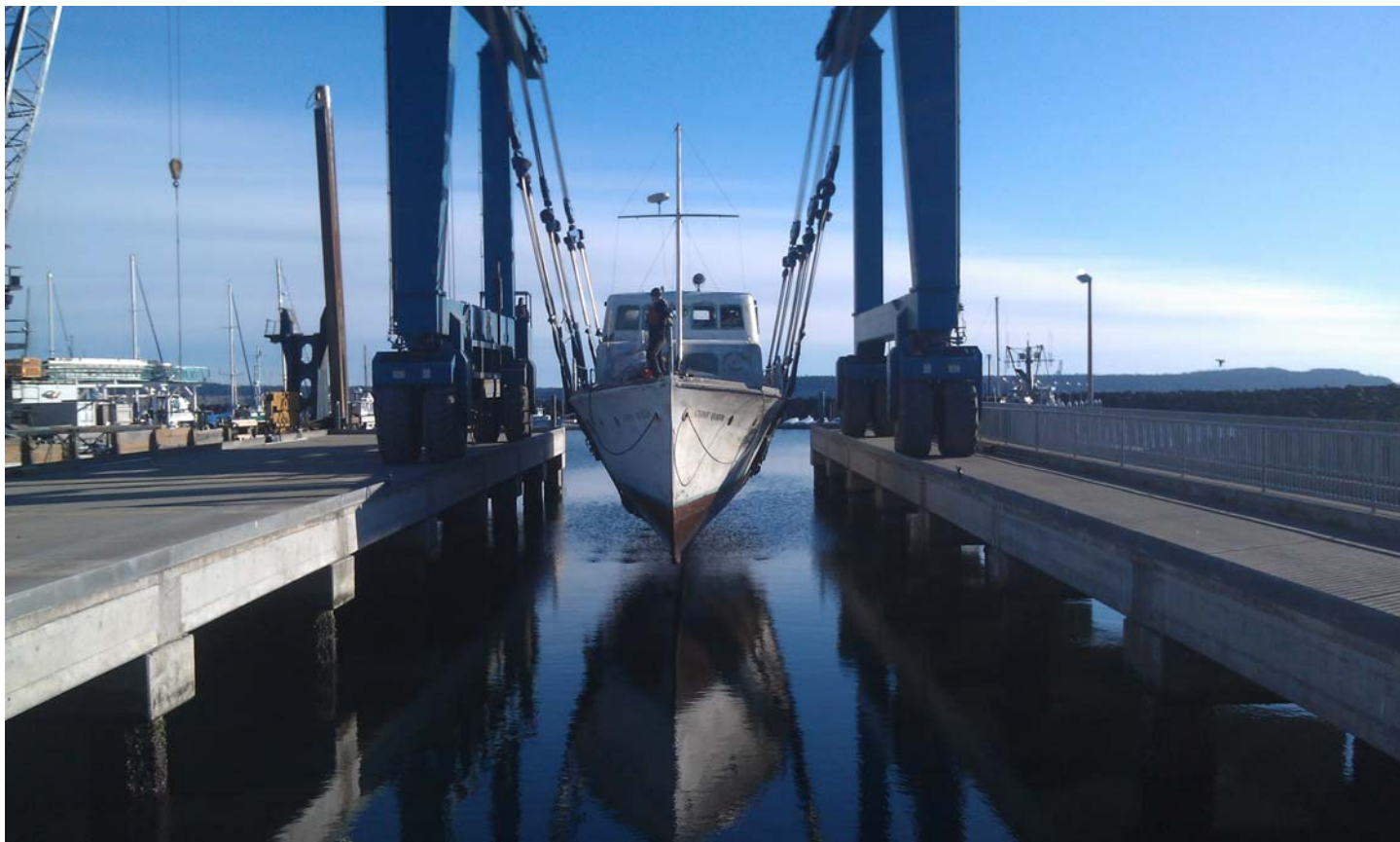

3. Operation Section Summary: <p>This report will be the last one generated for this response.</p> <p>Today: Global's night crew readied the GYPSY QUEEN for tow. At 0400 Dunlap Towing dispatched the FIDALGO to Steamboat Slough, took the GYPSY QUEEN alongside at 0500 and proceeded to the mouth of the river with Global's night crew on board to monitor the vessel. Global's dive team departed the Seattle shop at 0500 and mobilized to Dunlap Towing in Everett to board the RAIDER and relieved the night crew at 0650. The GYPSY QUEEN departed Everett at 0700 under tow and proceeded under escort to Port Townsend. The GYPSY QUEEN arrived off Port Townsend at approximately 1130 and was fast to the dock at noon. Global demobilized the remaining gear from the GYPSY QUEEN and she was shifted into the slings and lifted from the water at 1250.</p> <p>Global's crew departed Port Townsend and returned to Seattle.</p> <p>In Seattle - disposal of the hazardous materials continued.</p> <p>Tomorrow: The pumps, hoses and other gear removed from the GYPSY QUEEN will be decontaminated and returned to ready status. Hazardous materials disposal should be completed tomorrow.</p>
