The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Region 9 is working to protect residents of Casamero lake Chapter by cleaning up leftover waste from past uranium mining operations.

Uranium mining operations occurred throughout the Navajo Nation from the 1940s to the 1980s. The Cobb Nuclear Company operated uranium mines in the Casamero Lake Chapter area. Uranium ore was mined and taken out of the area. The USEPA is looking at two mines called the Section 32 and Section 33 mines.

Diné Bikéyah bikáá'góó t'óó'áhayóógo Łeetsoh hadas geed t'ah nahdéé' náhást'éí ts'áadah dóó dízdiin dóó náhást'éí ts'áadah dóó tseebídiin yihahéédáq' ádaat'é. Cobb Nuclear Company wolyéego kwii Tsétah Tó'ak'ólí Táá Sinilí nahósá'gi ɬeetsoh hadéízgeed. Łeetsoh haadas geedééh éí nahgóó ch'íhesgéh. Kin Náhálgaidéé' Ni'asdzaán Yik'ihdéézíí' Bił Hazáadóó naakigo Section 32 dóó Section 33 gi Łeetsoh nasgeed yééhgí nełkah.

At the Section 32 mine, there is an unfenced deep mineshaft at the southeast portion of the site. At the Section 33 mine, there are mining waste piles that contain some leftover uranium ore.

Díí Section 32 dóó Shádi'áah dóó ha'a'aahjígo t'ahdii ɬeetsoh hahasgííhhééh góyaa nídzaa góne' ahoozdžá doo ndi bich'ááh anít'i'dah. Section 33 jí' éí leezh ɬeetsoh bił haageedééh ɬeetsoh t'áá bił altah go' ákóó yanáá'á.

The leftover uranium ore has more radiation than the surrounding area and people should avoid touching it or walking near the mines.

Díí leezh ɬeetsoh bił hadasgeedgo t'áá' ákóó yáádaa'áhígúú t'áá yéego wódahdi nida'akidgo bits'á daazil ba'át'e' hóló' áko bila'ashdla'ii hada'asgeed yééhgí leezh t'áadoo bídólñihí dóó ákwii t'áadoo naháhá doo.

The USEPA Region 9 Superfund Emergency Response Section will conduct a preliminary assessment of uranium ore and mining waste at the two mines. We will share this information and talk with the community about cleanup options.
