Below find a list of ARAR's that are applicable to the proposed removal action of waste containers considered hazardous to take place at the Custom Metal Finishing Site located at 763 Industrial Park Drive, Shelby, Oceana County, Michigan. The requirements are all part of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (NREPA) and include:

Part 31, Water Resources Protection

Part 111, Hazardous Waste Management

Part 115, Solid Waste Management

Part 121, Liquid Industrial Wastes

Part 201, Environmental Response

David,

I'm currently working on the Action Memorandum to secure funding to conduct a removal at 4407 Lovers Lane. I hope to have the Action Memo completed by the first week in March and start the site in April. I have results as high as 7100 mg/kg for total lead, and as high as 120 mg/kg for TCLP. The former owner of the home died a couple weeks back and her son is moving into the house. He has two small children and his wife is pregnant, so I'd like to get moving on the removal as quickly as possible.

Attached is the ARAR request for the site. I would be grateful for a response by the end of next week, if possible. An email response is sufficient.
