As required by Paragraph 20 of the Administrative Order on Consent for Removal Action (Order) for the ESB, Inc. Site, three copies of this progress report for activities performed during May 2011 are submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

Although not required by the Order, this progress report includes those activities being performed at the request of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Environmental Protection Division (EPD) which have not been required by the EPA. These EPD-requested activities are indicated below in bold italics.

1. Response Actions Completed During May 2011 to Comply with the Order

- On May 9, 2011, Exide submitted to the EPA the progress report for the month of April 2011.

2. Data Anticipated or Activities Scheduled for the Next Month

- *The second round of quarterly groundwater sampling is scheduled to be performed on June 1, 2011. Field readings will be taken during that round of sampling.*

3. Problems Encountered in May 2011 or Anticipated

- *Contractual issues between the current property owner and Exide have delayed performance of the second round of groundwater sampling. The second round of groundwater sampling will be performed on June 1, 2011.*

4. Actions Taken in May 2011 to Mitigate Anticipated or Actual Problems

- *In response to its inability to reach an agreement with the current property owner regarding the second round of groundwater sampling, Exide has decided to proceed unilaterally with the sampling. The second round of sampling has been scheduled for June 1, 2011. Exide has also authorized its consultant to perform the third and fourth rounds of groundwater sampling as well and those rounds have been scheduled.*

5. Schedule for Completion of Actions to Mitigate Problems

- *The delayed second round of groundwater sampling will be performed on June 1, 2011.*

6. Copies of Analytical Data Received during May 2011

- No analytical data was received in May 2011.

7. Modifications to Response Action, RAP, and/or Schedule During May 2011

- No modifications to the Response Action or RAP were made in May 2011.
