Dear Joe:

This letter is to confirm the decisions that were made on the teleconference that we had on January 23, 2013 regarding additional monitoring/sampling of monitoring wells at the above referenced site. Per our discussion, the following work will be performed by the Respondents in this matter:

1. Locate and gauge (for groundwater elevation and LNAPL depth, if any) existing monitoring wells #s 5 and 6 and upgradient monitoring well #1. Collect groundwater samples from monitoring wells #s 1, 5 and 6 and have laboratory analysis performed for the following parameters:
 - a. Benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and total xylenes (BTEX) and naphthalene by EPA Method 8260B.
 - b. Parameters that are helpful in evaluating the effectiveness of the in-situ chemical oxidation treatment of petroleum-contaminated soils and groundwater at the site, including, but not limited to, major ions.


The above work is to be done as soon as practicable, considering weather and ability to locate the wells, but no later than February 15, 2013.

Preliminary laboratory analytical results from the sampling referenced above will be provided to EPA within 2 weeks of the sampling event. After reviewing those results, along with the final report from the cleanup project performed in December, EPA will make a determination regarding the possible need for and frequency of continued monitoring of existing wells #1, 5 and 6. EPA will also make a determination regarding the possible need for additional downgradient monitoring wells, as we have discussed.

The decisions memorialized in this letter are modifications to the Statement of Work which is set forth as Appendix A to the Unilateral Administrative Order issued by EPA in docket number RCRA-10-2013-0040.

Please call me when you have scheduled a date for the groundwater monitoring.
