
This memorandum requests your concurrence on the proposed removal action at the Blackfeet Asbestos, TCE and Lead-based Paint Site on the Blackfeet Indian Reservation in Montana. Redlegation of Authority R-14-2 gives you the authority to concur on nationally significant or precedent-setting removals.

My staff has discussed this proposed removal with your staff in the Program Operations and Coordination Division (POCD).
