The following has been prepared to summarize pertinent operational actions and/or outcomes associated with the response to the referenced incident. This summary covers the time period from the time of derailment (approximately 08:41 on January 31, 2014) until 08:00 on 02/01/14.

January 31, 2014:

08:41: Derailment occurs.

08:41 – 09:10: Notifications occur to internal CN personnel who mobilize, begin rallying contractors and make various agency notifications.

09:30: Steve Kelly – CN Trainmaster on-site.

09:45: Perry County EMA and possibly MDEQ on-site inspecting, damming and diking of surface waters.

11:20: Chris Lanoue – CN Dangerous Goods Officer on-site.

12:00: USES on-site.

11:00: First entry to conduct assessment, inspection and perform some actions to stop leaks.

11:45: Bob Strong – CN Environment on-site.

Begin surface water and soils impact assessment.

Spill containment (damming / diking), absorbent boom deployment and storm water protection.

12:30: Second entry to conduct more thorough inspection and stop leaks.

Tactical approach to addressing leaking railcars containing dangerous goods or other materials is developed and initiated.

14:00: Work continues on a leaking liquid fertilizer car.

14:00 - 15:00: Contractors begin arriving (Hulcher and B&P).

16:00: Connestoga, Rovers and Associates (CRA) on-site to begin air monitoring.

Approximately 16:00 to 22:00: General wrecking operations begin.

17:00 US EPA on-site. Leo Francendese meets with C. Lanoue (CN).

22:00 (approx): CN met with USEPA and other agencies. USEPA – Notification of Federal interest
Roll agencies into CN's established unified command.

February 1, 2014:

02:00: Staging of all derailed railcars was accomplished.

06:30: Shift-change safety briefing was conducted.

08:00 (approx): A meeting to deliver and discuss CN's initial IAP was conducted and an update was provided by section heads of the unified command was conducted at 0800 on 02/01/14.
