RADIATION WARNING SIGNS AT A&B MINE NO. 3 IN CAMERON, AZ

The US Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) is working with Navajo Nation EPA (NNEPA) to prevent exposure to hazardous materials at abandoned uranium mines in Cameron and the surrounding areas. USEPA found that A&B Mine No. 3, near HWY 89 and the Little Colorado River in Cameron (see map below), has elevated radiation levels from former mining activities. In response the USEPA will be posting signs in spring 2014 (shown at right) to warn community members to stay away from the mine site as USEPA continues to conduct an environmental investigation that will determine future protective measures. People should not build, gather, play, dig, or have livestock corrals near to, or on the mine.

USEPA and NNEPA will continue to work throughout Cameron and the surrounding area to eliminate exposure to hazardous abandoned uranium mine material. We will be updating the community regularly as work progresses.
