History

The Delta Mills Removal Site is a 0.42 acre lot which was formerly part of the Delta Mills textile dyeing and finishing plant which was closed in 2006. The Site is located at 4351 Brickyard Road, Wallace, Marlboro County South Carolina 29596. The 0.42-acre parcel consists of two above ground storage tanks and a pump house.

While the facility was in operation, the tanks were used to store waste oil. Presently, the facility is not operational and waste oil at the facility contains high concentrations of PCBs and is being stored in deteriorating above-ground storage tanks. There has been a release of contaminated waste oil into the pump house and soil outside of the pump house.

The 620-acre Delta Mills facility, a former textile dyeing and finishing plant, is not a part of this removal action.

Upcoming Activities

EPA has evaluated the site conditions and collected waste oil and soil samples. Large volumes of waste oil, oily water and sludge at the Site were determined to contain polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs). Additionally, PCBs were found in the soil outside the pump house.

The EPA's proposed action is to remove waste oil, sludge, oily water and soil contaminated with PCBs and/or hazardous substances from the Site. The scope of work will include the following actions:

- Notify local officials and the public about the Site;
- Secure the Site;
- Contain, treat and/or dispose of waste oil, sludge, oily water and soil containing PCBs and other hazardous substances;
- Prevent further releases and spills;
- Restore areas which are disturbed by the removal action.
