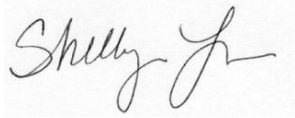
Dear Ms. Hauer:

This letter is to request Applicable or Relevant and Appropriate Requirements (ARAR) for the West Vermont Drinking Water Contamination Site, a residential neighborhood on West Vermont Street and Cossell Road in Indianapolis, Marion County, Indiana. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is planning to issue a Unilateral Administrative Order (UAO) to conduct time-critical removal actions at the Site to mitigate a threat to human health and the environment.

EPA conducted a hydrogeologic investigation in November and December 2011, and documented hazardous substances, including vinyl chloride, in groundwater that serves as a drinking water source. Time-critical removal activities will include connecting residential properties within the Site boundary to a municipal drinking water supply and completing residential well abandonment.
