



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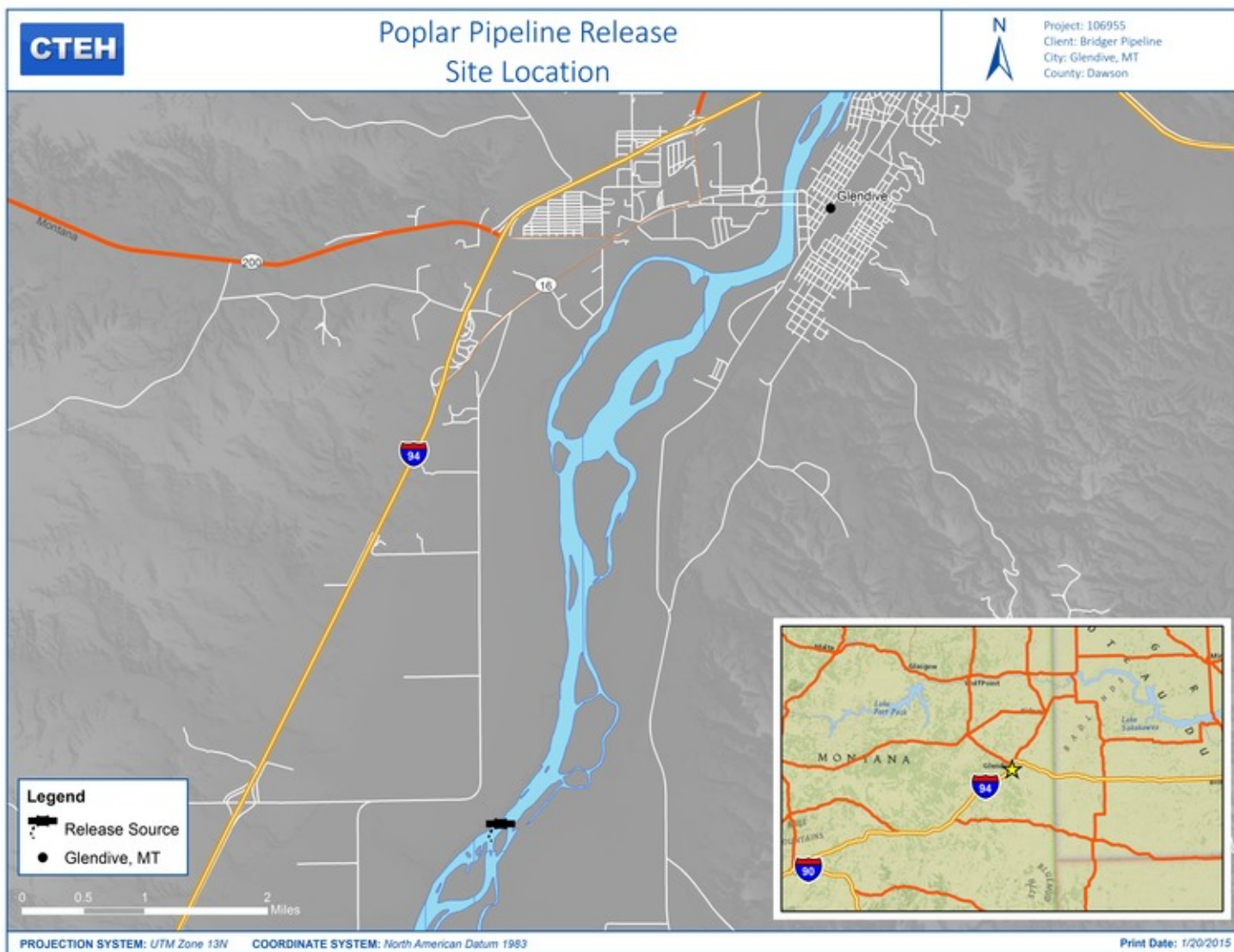

### Initial Situation

On January 17, 2015 at approximately 10:30 Mountain Time, a pipeline owned by Bridger Pipeline LLC released oil into the Yellowstone River. The release was approximately 7 miles upstream from the I-94 Yellowstone River bridge in Glendive, MT.

<b>Objective(s)</b>	
1.) Provide for life safety first. 2.) Sample, monitor, and ensure safety of downstream water intakes including Glendive. 3.) Evaluate presence of crude oil within vicinity of the incident. Take measures to prevent further migration to the Yellowstone River. 4.) Find downstream locations at which to prevent further migration of product. 5.) Investigate and identify locations for the reasonable recovery of free product.	
<b>Operational Period Command Emphasis</b>	
1.) Continue log complaints/concerns from residents, business, etc. as they come in. Utilize USCG personnel to reach out to these individuals as needed per UC. 2.) Support downstream intake facilities, including but not limited to, Montana Dakota Utilities (MDU) and the Glendive Water Treatment Plant. The Glendive Water Treatment Plant should be contacted daily by USGC personnel. MDU should be contacted on a regular basis. Other intake facilities should be contacted as needed per UC. 3.) A weekly overflight will be conducted on Tuesday, 2/17/2015. These overflights should be used to identify possible migration of contamination. Information gained from the overflights will be communicated to UC. 4.) Product samples and upstream water samples should be collected for a degradation study performed by NOAA. This should take place at the discretion of UC. 5.) Identify agriculture users who are in the floodplain and begin reaching out to those as needed per UC.	
<b>General Situational Awareness</b>	
High hazard working around Yellowstone River and banks. Heavy machinery at oil recovery operations. Road conditions due to inclement weather and/or mud. Cold stress hazard. Possible high wind hazard. If oiled wildlife is seen, do not handle or touch. Please call 1-888-959-8351 immediately. Situational awareness regarding possible raptor nesting sites near river for aerial and ground/water operations.

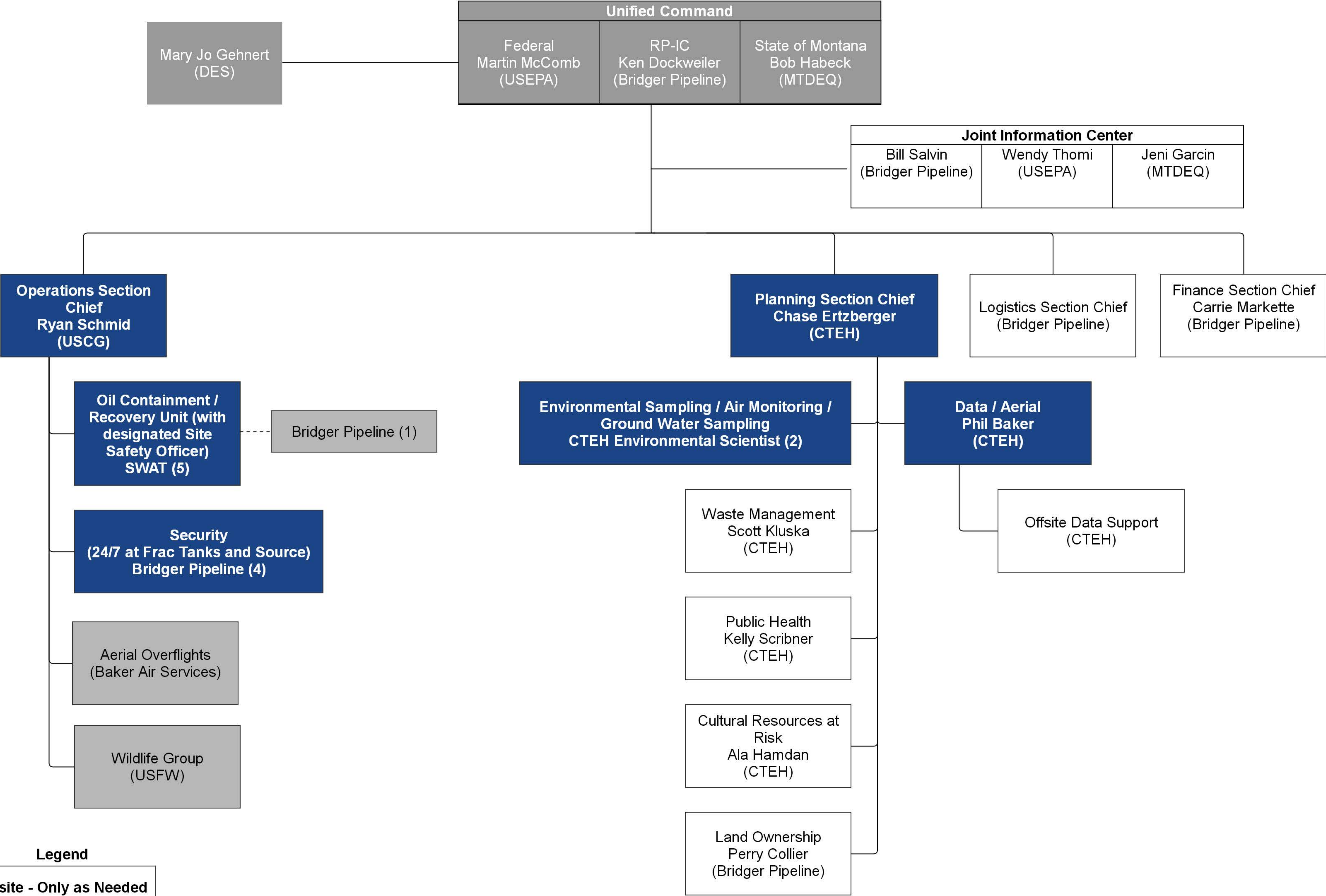

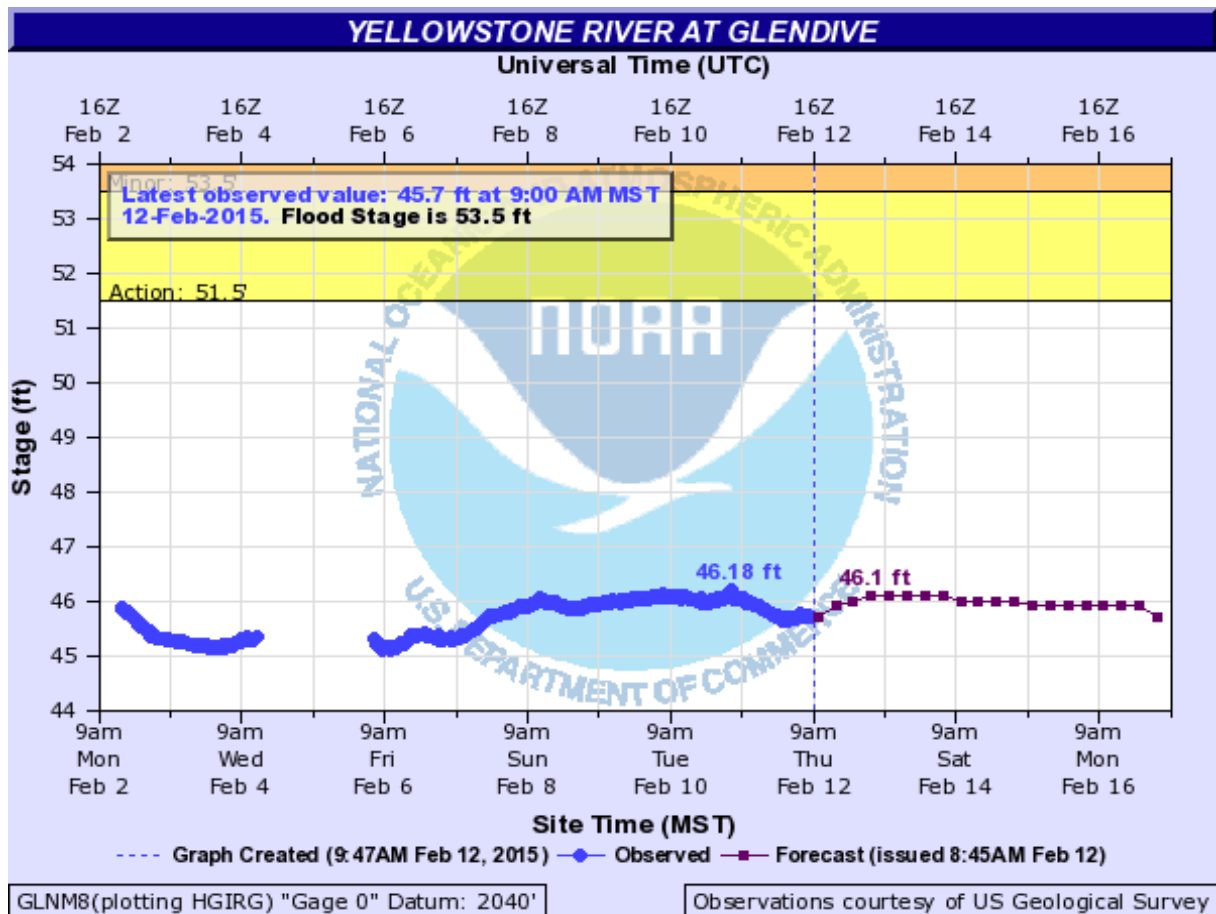

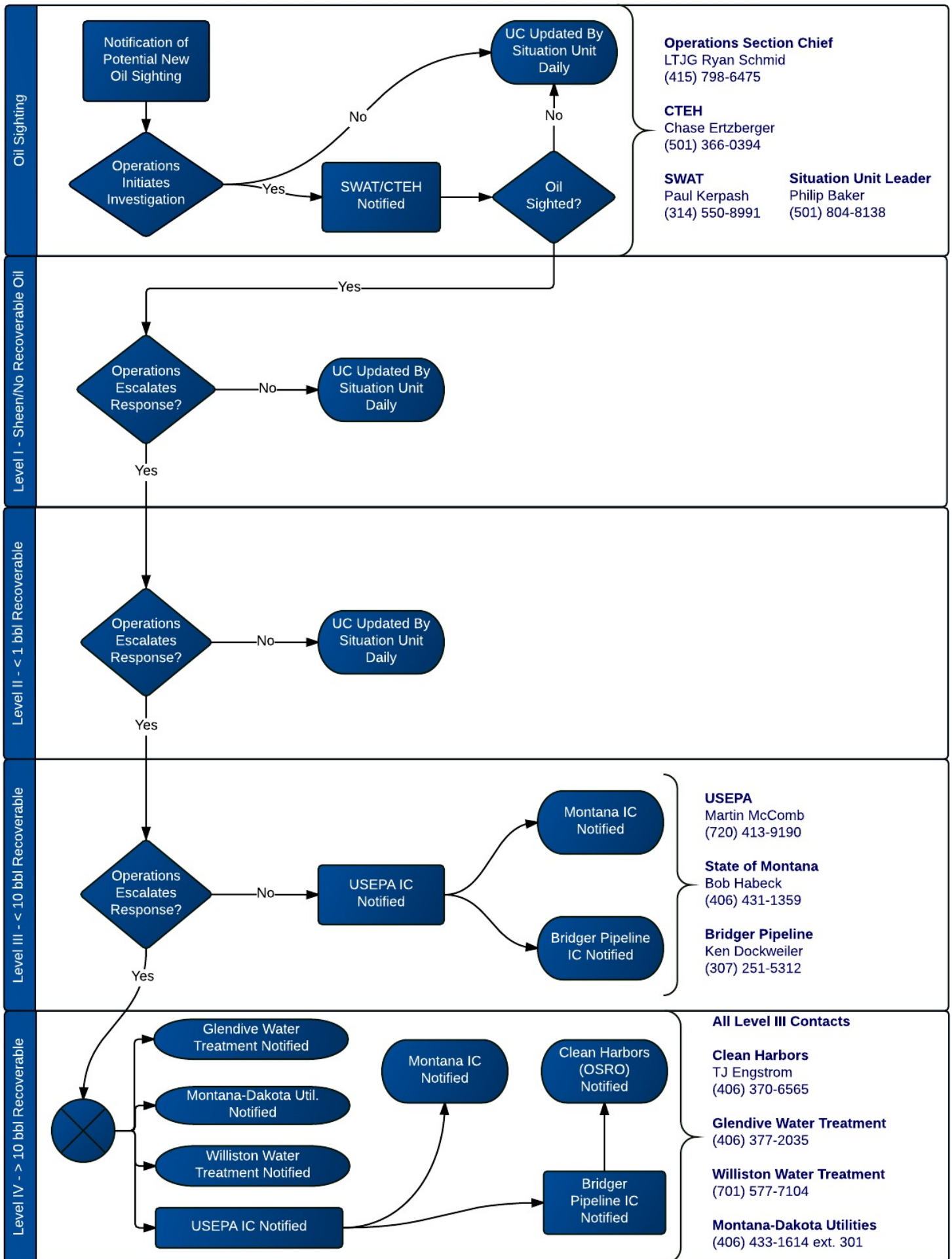
