

**Mississippi Resources Oil Spill  
Waste Management Plan  
Commencing April 17, 2015**

**Purpose:** *Management of waste generated during the following:*

- 1. Impacted soil, liquids, and debris generated during emergency response / remediation activities.*
- 2. Recovery of impacted surface water collected during emergency response / remediation activities.*
- 3. Collection, management, and disposal of impacted spill response materials (i.e., absorbents, booms etc) generated during emergency response / remediation activities.*
- 4. Decontamination fluids generated during emergency response / remediation activities.*
- 5. Removal of non impacted woody vegetation and other site debris*

**Mississippi Resources Responsibilities:**

1. Properly profile all waste streams for off site disposal at approved facilities
2. Contract transportation company(ies)
3. Coordinate loading of any waste into trucks, roll off containers, frac tanks, and other approved vessels.
4. Provide record of quantities disposed for each waste stream and record retention of the waste from point of generation to disposal (cradle to grave).

**Safety:** Site personnel will review and adhere to health and safety procedures while in the exclusion zone.

**Security:** Site personnel will sign in each morning. A verification head count will performed at lunch break and end of day out briefing.

**Waste Stream #1- Crude Oil Impacted SOLIDS:**

- A waste profile was generated for impacted soils, vegetative debris, absorbents and other solids based on generator knowledge and laboratory analysis. The subject waste was classified as non hazardous. Because Covington County is a flow controlled county, all solids will be sent to Pine Belt Regional Mgt Authority in Runnelstown, MS. Waste profile pending status approval. The waste profile number is
- MS Resources personnel designated to sign manifest is Bruce Smith and Jerry King.
- Copies of the manifest and weight tickets will be collected on site each day and retained for reporting purposes.
- The waste will be loaded directly into roll off boxes and transported to the approved landfill for disposal.
- Solid Waste / Household Garbage will be sent to Pine Belt Regional Solid Waste for disposal.

- All solid waste generated from this site will be sent to Pine Belt Regional Solid Waste Management Authority.

**Transportation:** Mississippi Resources and Complete Environmental will coordinate truck traffic and arrange for escorts, as necessary, into and out of the work area.

**Crew / personnel:**

Purpose: Directing safety and logistics of removal of the trucks from the work area and documenting number of loads removed from the site.

**Waste Stream #2- Crude Oil Impacted LIQUIDS:**

- This waste stream will include all free product, impacted water, surface water
- Free product recovery will be achieved using vacuum trucks supplied by Kelley Brothers Contractors.
- Recovered liquids will be sent to the water tanks on the Blackstone #1 location to decant.
- If off site disposal/recycling is necessary, liquids will be sent to Liquid Environmental Solutions in Mobile, AL.
- No waste profile is necessary for disposal. This waste is classified as non hazardous waste.
- MS Resources personnel designated to sign manifest are Bruce Smith and Jerry King.
- Copies of the manifest and load tickets will be collected on site each day and retained for reporting purposes.
- The waste will be loaded directly into vacuum trucks and transported to the approved disposal facility for disposal.

**Transportation:** MS Resources and Complete Environmental will coordinate truck traffic and arrange for escorts, as necessary, into and out of the work area.

**Crew / personnel:**



- Decontamination liquids will be sent to Liquid Environmental Solutions in Mobile, AL for disposal/recycling.
- A waste profile is not required by this facility.
- MS Resources personnel designated to sign manifest are Bruce Smith and Jerry King.
- Copies of the manifest and weight tickets will be collected on site each day and retained for reporting purposes.

No other waste streams are expected to be generated from this incident.
