

Multiple Stakeholder Hattiesburg Derailment Workshop

Workplan Assignments and Proposed Schedule

The below listed plans have been identified for both creation and presentation during the Multiple Stakeholder Hattiesburg Derailment Workshop in Hattiesburg, MS. Additionally, the groups working on these plans are listed next to the plan.

The morning session of the workshop is a 2 hr co presentation by Arcadis representing CN and EPA/ERT. The presentation is a Crude Oil Response Awareness session. The remaining day and a half is a series of presentations and open discussions of both the plans and the accompanying expected two Incident Action Plans.

6. Oil Containment and Recovery Plan (CRA/CN)
7. Shoreline Cleanup Assessment Techniques Report (MDEQ, EPA, CRA)
8. Waste Management Plan (CRA/CN)
9. Operations and Maintenance Plan (CRA/CN/EPA)

The Health and Safety Plan will be developed but not presented (CRA/CN/).

Two Incident Action Plans will be developed primarily by CRA/CN with input from EPA, MDEQ and Forrest County EMA. The plans will be used as a framework to be referred to for the organizational structure, priorities, objectives and tactics used during the workshop. A brief overview will be discussed during the course of the 2 day event.
