On September 29, 2015, acting pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the federal Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1986, ("CERCLA") as amended, I performed a CERCLA emergency removal action at the residential premises at 19 Park Street, Ellenville, NY.

This emergency removal action involved retrieving and transporting one 35-gallon drum of used motor oil and one 35-gallon drum of waste, solvent-borne paint from the backyard of a vacant house at the above address. This waste was deemed to be abandoned, as that term is defined in CERCLA, and was not generated by a commercial business.

I certify that this emergency removal action was conducted pursuant to federal regulations at § 40 CFR Part 300, the National Contingency Plan, and was not inconsistent with those regulations or other applicable federal laws.
