THE CALLER IS REPORTING A TANKER TRUCK STRUCK A RAIL CAR. THE CAUSE OF THE INCIDENT IS UNDER INVESTIGATION. THE CALLER STATED THERE WAS A FIRE DUE TO THE INCIDENT. CALLER STATED IT IS UNKNOWN IF THERE ARE ANY INJURIES OR EVACUATIONS. CALLER STATED IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT THE INCIDENT OCCURRED ON RAILROAD PROPERTY AT 0955 PST (LOCAL TIME). CALLER STATED THE RAILCAR WAS NOT A PART OF A TRAIN, IT IS BELIEVED THERE ARE SIX (6) CARS INVOLVED, CONTENTS ARE UNKNOWN. CALLER STATED THERE IS AN UNKNOWN MATERIAL LEAKING INTO WILLAMETTE RIVER.
