Continue test pit excavations and soil excavations, as appropriate, based on ongoing Geoprobe and drilling investigation.4. Continue monitoring/maintaining containment booms.5. Continue shoreline removal of debris and replacement of spent sorbents.6. Continue surface water quality monitoring and sampling.7. Obtain KYDEP approval of RI Work Plan.8. Continue monitoring absorbent boom at/near the Jackson water treatment plant intake.9. Continue subsurface investigation including Geoprobng, drilling, monitoring and/or recovery well installation.10. Remove grubbing debris from derailment site.11. Relocation of contractor staging area.12. Continue to prepare and submit daily SITREPs and IAPs to KYDEP and USEPA.
