Continue surface water quality monitoring and sampling. 5. Obtain KYDEP approval of RI Work Plan. 6. Continue monitoring absorbent boom at/near the Jackson water treatment plant intake. 7. Continue subsurface investigation including Geoprobings, drilling, monitoring and/or recovery well installation. 8. Remove grubbing debris from derailment site. 9. Continue to prepare and submit daily SITREPs and IAPs to KYDEP and USEPA.
