## Please Bring Any of the Acceptable Items Below to a Collection Station



### Examples of items we can accept:

- ◆ Spray paint
- ◆ Batteries
- ◆ Fluorescent bulbs
- ◆ Paint and solvents
- ◆ Home cleaners and solvents
- ◆ Pesticides, weed killer, insect repellents
- ◆ Propane tanks
- ◆ Gas, motor or generator oil
- ◆ TVs, computers, microwaves, phones, or items with a circuit board
- ◆ Fire extinguishers

### Examples of items we cannot accept:

- ◆ Explosives/radioactive items
- ◆ Asbestos
- ◆ Electrical appliances with plugs or batteries (products with no circuit board)
- ◆ Compressed gas cylinders, other than propane
- ◆ Large appliances (air conditioners, refrigerators, stoves, washers, etc.)
- ◆ Debris such as trash, trees or branches
- ◆ Medical/infectious waste (biohazard)
