GENERAL SITE DESCRIPTION: The Site is an active 35 acre landfill in St. Croix. On or about June 18, 2019 a fire at the landfill was detected. Efforts to extinguish the fire have been unsuccessful and the fire has grown in strength and intensity. The fire is now generating thick black smoke, chemical odors and emitting large quantities of particulate matter. On June 30, 2019, the VI government requested emergency EPA assistance to conduct air monitoring of the smoke plume and surrounding areas to help inform the nearby residential community and develop an evacuation strategy should that become necessary.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK:


In accordance with the Response Section in the SOW, START V shall provide response action support. The contractor shall perform the following activities:

1. Immediately mobilize 3 personnel to initiate air monitoring around the landfill at locations to be determined by the OSC.
2. Mobilize additional personnel as necessary to continue air monitoring on a 24 hour basis as requested
3. Supply air monitoring equipment for particulate, VOCs and other compounds as directed.

4. Establish area-Rae monitoring at the landfill within 3 days
5. Maintain a site log, and to perform photo-documentation of all field
6. Provide chronology of events to be provided to OSC less than 2 weeks after field activities have been completed.

In accordance with B-9 Local Clause EPA-B-32-103, Contractor will notify the Contracting Officer, in writing, at least 5 days prior to the date when, in the Contractor's best judgment, the work will reach the point at which the total amount payable by the Government, including any cost for termination for convenience, will approximate 85% of the total amount currently allotted to the Task Order for performance of the applicable items.
