INCIDENT SUMMARY

Caller reported they were frying food inside the home when the mercury thermometer inside the oil pan broke sometime during cooking. Caller stated they did not notice that the thermometer had broken until after they had eaten. Caller contacted Poison Control upon identifying mercury beads inside the oil. Poison Control recommended that the home be ventilated and disposal arranged through local authorities.

DERR notified John Chartier (DE- Central Utah) and Paul Peronard (EPA) about the incident. EPA plans to respond to the incident at this time.
