Site Milestones

In the last few months, EPA focused on Transportation and Disposal Activities on the site:

- Shipped approximately 95% of bulked waste (collected from totes, drums, and other containers) off-site
- Pumped out wastewater treatment tanks, properly disposed the contents off-site, and recycled the tanks
 - Contents included almost 186,000 gallons of water and 106 cubic yards of sediment and sludge
- As of June 30, Lincoln Recycling is no longer on site actively recycling/salvaging materials. However, Robindale Energy continues to remove their raw coal products.

Upcoming Work and Next Steps

EPA's next phase of Removal Activities at the site will address the "by-products" area that contains coal tar, sludge, coke oven gas residues, and other wastes. EPA mobilized back to the site on July 6 to begin recycling and disposing the coal tar wastes off-site.



EPA signed an **Action Memo Amendment** in June 2021 to change the scope of the original 2020 Action Memo. This Amendment allows for EPA to recycle some wastes from the "by-products" area, in addition to traditional off-site disposal.
