Afternoon Everyone,

I wanted to take the opportunity to add context to something mentioned in this most recent letter. EPA has correctly articulated that in 2020 CDPHE requested assistance from EPA to address remaining tailings within the Telluride valley floor. This request was made on behalf of the San Miguel BOCC. On December 1, 2020, CDPHE received a letter from the San Miguel BOCC requesting that the State's CERCLA team coordinate with EPA to address these tailings. Since the State does not have resources or authority to address these tailings, CDPHE passed along this request to EPA.

CDPHE supports the San Miguel BOCC request and will continue to remain available to offer assistance and advice consistent with the National Contingency Plan.
