INTRODUCTION

On 26 August 2022, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region I On-Scene Coordinator (OSC) Wing Chau emailed the Removal Program Preliminary Assessment/Site Investigation (PA/SI) Report and Closure Memo for the East Millinocket Paper Mill Site to relevant parties including potentially responsible parties (PRPs). On 26 August 2022, PRP Jason Inhoff of Katahdin KI 50 responded via email to OSC Chau regarding clarifications to the PA/SI Report and Closure Memo. The purpose of this memo is to include Mr. Inhoff's comments and/or clarifications into the East Millinocket Paper Mill Site File.

SITE OWNERSHIP

The East Millinocket Paper Mill (the Site) is located at 50 Main Street in East Millinocket, Penobscot County, Maine. The former paper mill closed around 2014. The property has since been owned by a series of investors including Katahdin KI 50 LLC (Katahdin KI 50). Mr. Jason Inhoff of Katahdin KI 50 has provided the following information regarding the ownership.

- 1) Katahdin KI 50 sold the steam plant to Metro Industrial Wrecking in September of 2019, so we are not the owner as listed.
- 2) Katahdin KI 50 did not hire Metro to do any work as they owned the plant when the work was done.
- 3) The town authorized Karma Environmental to do the work based on a request from Metro.
