# Project Objectives

---

- Identify the extent of lead and PCB contaminated fill in the neighborhood
- Eliminate the exposure to contaminated soils by excavating areas of contaminated surface soils and restoring the affected areas with clean material

# Recap of EPA's 2005 Field Activities:

---

- 35 properties sampled
- 32 properties determined to require removal of contaminated surface soil
- Excavation completed at 12 properties











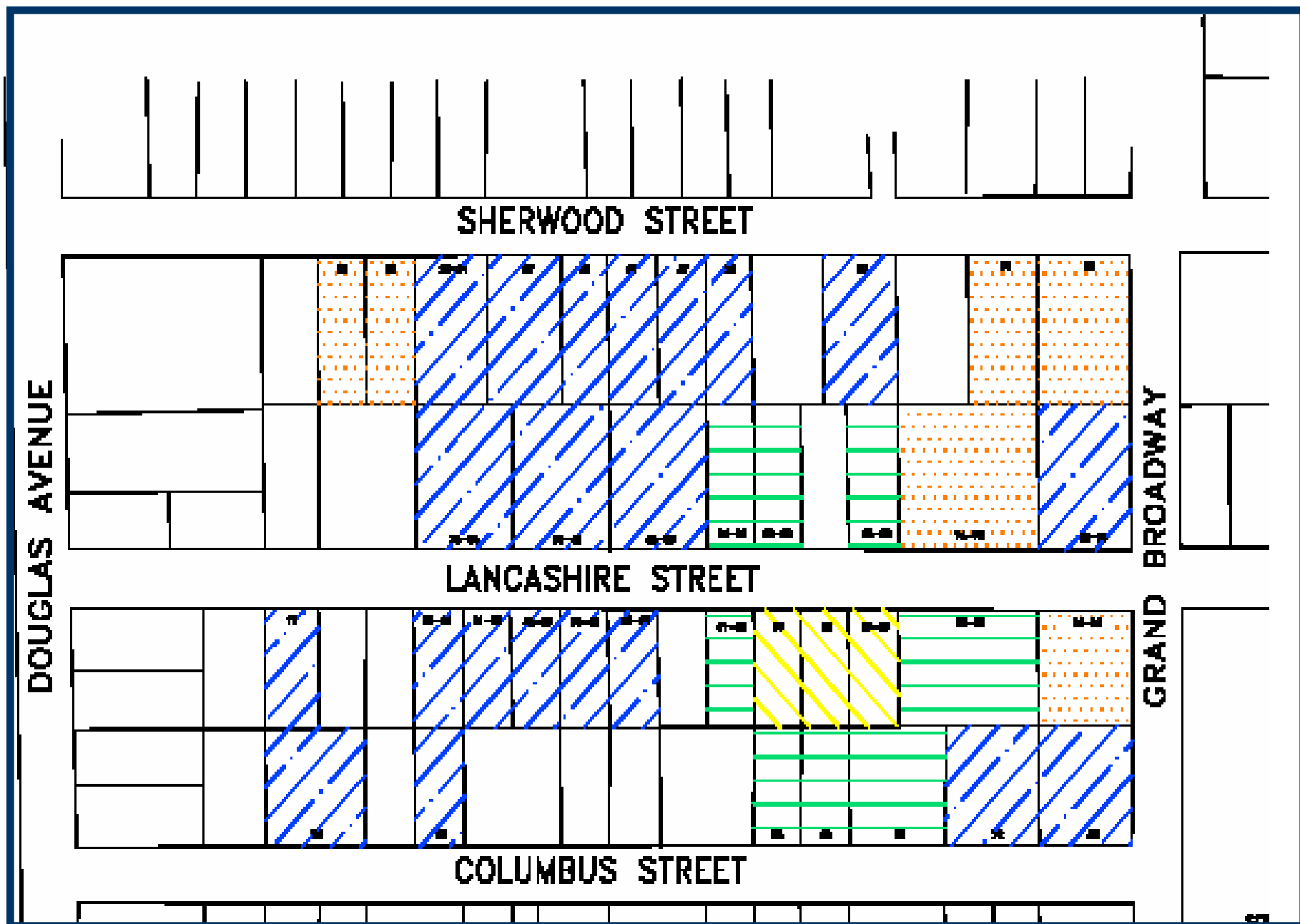

# Overview of Upcoming 2006 Removal Activities

- Excavate contaminated surface soil from 20 residential properties on Columbus, Sherwood and Lancashire Streets
  - Begin with the outermost properties and work in towards the three vacant lots on Lancashire Street
  - Stage contaminated soil on the three vacant lots
- Ship contaminated material off site for disposal
- Restoration activities on all 32 affected properties
- Excavate contaminated soil from the three vacant lots
- Re-grade and place clean fill material and loam on the three lots

# General Information

- Work will occur from 8 to 4:30 Monday through Friday
- Anticipated to take between 3 – 5 days to excavate each property
- Expect an increase in truck traffic
- Dust suppression activities
