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On 12/16/2023, about 0822 hours (hrs.), I, Deputy H. Wolfe, was on routine patrol of the shopping center at 560 E Castle Pines Pkwy, City of Castle Pines, Douglas County, Colorado when I observed a blue 55 gallon plastic barrel sitting in the middle of the parking, apparently abandoned.

The barrel was sealed and did not have any markings or identifiers attached. I recognized the barrel was the same barrel I had observed sitting outside a Dodge Ram 3500 pickup with custom 22" chrome rims, and was pulling a travel trailer style toy hauler RV parked in the same location on 12/15/23 about 0800 hrs. The barrel had been placed directly against the trailer. Both vehicles displayed TX registration plates.

About 1730 hrs. on 12/15/23, I saw the same truck and RV on the side of the road on the southbound on-ramp from Castle Pines Pkwy to southbound Interstate 25, being assisted by Westside towing.

Without opening the drum, and only lightly kicking the side of the drum, I was able to determine the drum contained a liquid and was only partially full. I requested South Metro Fire (SMFD) to respond for the unknown possible Hazardous Material drum.

While waiting for SMFD to arrive. I called Westside Towing to see if they had any useful information about the truck and RV. Upon calling Westside, I learned the truck was a 2010 Dodge Ram 3500 which displayed Texas registration [REDACTED]. The VIN on the truck was [REDACTED]. They had been called by "[REDACTED]" from phone number [REDACTED].

I called the number [REDACTED] and left a message to call me back. I called the number again, and it was answered by a female subject who identified herself as [REDACTED], handed the phone to a male subject, who verbally identified himself as [REDACTED], and provided an address of [REDACTED], Madisonville, TX 77864.

I requested dispatch clear [REDACTED] and the truck through NCIC/CCIC. I learned [REDACTED] was clear, no driver's license information was found, but the address matched what Kevin had told me.

The truck plate returned to a [REDACTED] at [REDACTED], Houston TX, 77039.

[REDACTED] told me he, "accidentally left the barrel at the shopping center." [REDACTED] told me the barrel contained some old diesel fuel, and old fuel pump and some old fuel lines. [REDACTED] said he had replaced the truck's fuel pump and fuel lines in the shopping center parking lot. [REDACTED] told me he was already in Amarillo, TX and was not planning on returning to this area. I advised him the barrel needed to be cleaned up and that I had the fire department at the scene to do so. [REDACTED] apologized for leaving the barrel. I told [REDACTED] I would be calling him back when I learned what was going to happen.

SMFD Engine 36 and SMFD Hazmat responded. I passed on the information I had learned about the barrel. SMFD determined the barrel was not leaking and they opted to not open the barrel. SMFD made arrangements with the Environmental Protection Agency Orphan Barrel Waste Program to come and retrieve the barrel.

I called the property owner and left a message about this incident. I called [REDACTED] back several times, but

he did not answer any of my calls. I left a message for him to call me back.

I was advised by SMFD that the cost for the EPA cleanup would be minimal if any cost to the property owner. However, if a private Hazmat cleanup company was required, the cost to the property owner would likely be \$5000.00 at minimum.

SMFD moved the drum away from any buildings and pedestrian traffic and marked it off with barrier tape. EPA was advised of the drum's location.

I provided SMFD my business card with this case number. SMFD advised their incident number is 23-049154.

All units then cleared.

My BWC was recording at the time of this report and may contain additional details and/or statements not included in my report.
