Removal Action Plan: Subsection Approvals and HASP Acceptance

Dear Mr. Miller:

In accordance with Section 8.9 of the Nov, 29, 2006 Administrative Settlement and Order on Consent for Removal Response Action, Docket No CERC-03-2007-0006DC, in order to facilitate work at the Site, the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approves the following sections of the Response Action Plan (RAP):

1. UGI RAP Section 3.9 (Demolition)

EPA approves Section 3.9 (Demolition) and associated activities with the demolition , contained in the UGI Columbia Response Action Plan (RAP) dated Dec 15, 2006. (Reviewers did not have comments on Section 3.9). The building demolition and associated work may be implemented immediately. It is EPA's understanding that silt fences will be installed prior to dropping the buildings.

2. Acceptance of HASP

The US EPA accepts the RAP Appendix B , the Site Health and Plan (HASP). It is EPA's understanding that PADEP's Jan 19, 2007 Comment 6, regarding minor spelling errors in the HASP, is currently being addressed.)

3. Workplan: Well Abandonment and Installation of Additional Monitoring Wells

The workplan for the Well Abandonment and Installation of Additional Monitoring Wells Former UGI Columbia Gas Plant Site Columbia, Pennsylvania dated March 2007. (EPA was the only reviewer having comments on the well Draft Work Plan) All EPA comments have adequately been addressed, and the well work plan may be implemented immediately.



A separate RAP approval will be forthcoming once it has been verified that the revised RAP submission satisfies reviewer comments.
