Consent to Enter Property
Private Drinking Water Sampling

1. The Undersigned understands that:
 - a. The United States Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”), and its employees, agents, contractors, and authorized representatives (collectively “Samplers”) are removal site evaluation at and around the Max Environmental Technologies property. EPA is performing the removal site evaluation in consultation with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (“PADEP”).
 - b. The removal site evaluation will consist of collecting private drinking water well samples for analysis and interpretation of data.
 - c. EPA’s removal site evaluation is being performed pursuant to EPA’s authority under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9601, et seq.

2. The Undersigned consents to entry to the Property by Samplers for the purposes of:
 - a. Reconnaissance of private drinking water well location(s) and condition;
 - b. Collecting water samples from the private drinking water well(s) located on your property;
 - c. Conducting environmental monitoring and taking notes and pictures to document sampling activities; and
 - d. Providing EPA resources, which will include 1 or more support vehicles, monitoring equipment, and required sampling bottleware.

3. The Undersigned understands that these activities will require entry to the Property, particularly to a tap or spigot located closest to the well head and before the water supply is introduced into any storage tanks or treatment units. Sampling activities will take approximately 60 minutes. EPA intends to provide at least seven (7) days advanced notice to the Undersigned, identifying the planned work to be done, the proposed date of access, and any further details to complete the planned work. EPA and its contractors intend to use diligent efforts to minimize interference with the residents' use and enjoyment of the Property.

Sampling shall be performed at a time agreed upon by the Property owner and EPA.

4. The Undersigned provides consent for the above-described activities until the earlier of:
- a. The transfer of the Property to another person or entity;
 - b. The Undersigned's revocation of consent; or
 - c. The Undersigned's receipt of notice from EPA that access to the Property is no longer needed in connection with the removal site evaluation.
5. The Undersigned agrees to notify the following individual, or such other person as may be identified by EPA in the future, of any pending transfer of the Property, a change in the Undersigned's contact information, and/or the Undersigned's revocation of consent to perform the above-described activities:
