**JUNE 1 – JUNE 15, 2007 PROGRESS REPORT  
UGI COLUMBIA GAS PLANT SUPERFUND SITE  
COLUMBIA, PENNSYLVANIA**

**Actions Taken During June 1 – June 15, 2007**

- Penn Environmental and Remediation, Inc.'s (Penn E&R's) construction trailer was delivered and set-up during the week of June 4, 2007.
- Penn E&R mobilized to the Site on June 11, 2007. During that week, the following progress was made.
  - They repaired the existing silt fence and construction entrance.
  - They started removing the floor slab and foundation of former Building 1.
  - They demolished the wooden and concrete ramps to the concrete lagoon. They also started removing the front wall of the lagoon.
  - They demolished the remaining concrete structures.
  - They started installing the stormwater structures from FES-1 to the collection pond.
- We started arranging for the disposal of the water and cuttings that were generated during the drilling activities.

**Sampling Results/Data Submitted During June 1 – June 15, 2007**

- There were no sampling results or data submitted during this period.

**Deliverables Submitted During June 1 – June 15, 2007**

- There were no deliverables submitted during this period.

**Activities Planned for June 16 – June 30, 2007**

- Penn E&R will work on the following tasks.
  - They will finish removing the floor slab and foundation of former Building 1, and finish removing the front wall of the concrete lagoon.
  - They will continue installing the stormwater structures and collection pond.
  - They will break the slab of former Building 2 and Concrete Pad 2 into pieces with a maximum dimension of three feet in any direction.
  - They will start regarding the Site.
- We will continue arranging for the disposal of the water and cuttings that were generated during the drilling activities.

- GEI Consultant, Inc. will start preparing their report detailing the well installation and sampling activities.
