The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (Emergency Response and Removal Branch) will begin an assessment today, June 27, 2007, at a number of homes in Wescott Plantation. On June 15, 2007, the S. C. Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) requested EPA perform an assessment to determine the presence and level of methane gas in homes in the area. EPA will conduct air monitoring using instruments that provide real-time data. EPA is coordinating its efforts with the SCDHEC, the City of North Charleston, the local fire department and Wescott Plantation residents.
