Here's the follow-through on your request to have the below
(reference to 10/2006 PSI Indoor Air Quality Data) air quality data reviewed.
It was reviewed by a senior member of the Agency for Toxic Substances Disease Registry/Centers for
Disease Control (ATSDR/CDC). This was his conclusion concerning that data :

"The levels of Total Organic Compounds as reported in the analytical
data (the 2 homes) made available to ATSDR Emergency Response Team
(ERT) did not present a public health threat. In addition, the individual constituents contained
within the Total Organic Compounds as reported in the analytical data
made available to ATSDR ERT did not present a public health threat."

The clean bill of health for the air quality on these two samples should help resolve
your indoor air quality questions.

I am still waiting on the air sample we pulled from your outdoor passive vapor extraction system exhaust.
I should have those results in 2 weeks and will share them with you at that time.
