I received the data (*reference to the 6-07 SUMA canister air samples that were pulled from the outdoor vents of the vapor extraction systems*) and had a senior official review the data at the Agency for Toxic Substances Disease Registry/Center for Disease Control (ATSDR/CDC). He had the following to say :

I have reviewed the 2 Outdoor Vent sample results & the Background sample results which were analyzed using the EPA Method TO-15. The analytical results indicated no total organic or individual organic constituents which would present a public health threat in either of the Outdoor Vent samples nor the Background sample.

Your sample is identified as WSP-01.
