The purpose of this letter is to document EPA's concurrence with the *Conceptual Approach to Removal Action* ("Conceptual Approach"), submitted to EPA on behalf of FCI USA, Inc. ("FCI") by HRP Associates, Inc. ("HRP") on May 2, 2007, as amended by the *Addendum, Conceptual Approach to Removal Action* ("Addendum") dated June 12, 2007 (the Conceptual Approach, as revised by the Addendum, is hereinafter called the "Revised Conceptual Approach"). The Revised Conceptual Approach relates to a removal action to be conducted by FCI at the Wampus Milford Associates Site, located at 80 Wampus Lane in Milford, Connecticut.

Following our receipt of the Conceptual Approach on May 2, 2007, EPA provided technical comments dated May 10, 2007 in writing to FCI. HRP responded to EPA's May 10, 2007 comments on the Conceptual Approach on FCI's behalf by letter dated May 25, 2007.

On June 7, 2007, I participated in a telephone conference call with Andrew White and Brian Washburn of HRP, speaking on behalf of FCI, and Gennady Shteynberg and David Ringquist of the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection ("CTDEP"). EPA received the Addendum from FCI on June 12, 2007 via e-mail following the June 7, 2007 conference call.

While EPA concurs in the approach to the contemplated removal action set forth in the Revised Conceptual Approach, we do so with the understanding, based on your May 25, 2007 correspondence, that some of the additional details requested in our May 10, 2007 letter will be provided in the Soil Excavation Work Plan deliverable that will be required under the anticipated Administrative Order on Consent ("AOC") to be signed by EPA and FCI.
