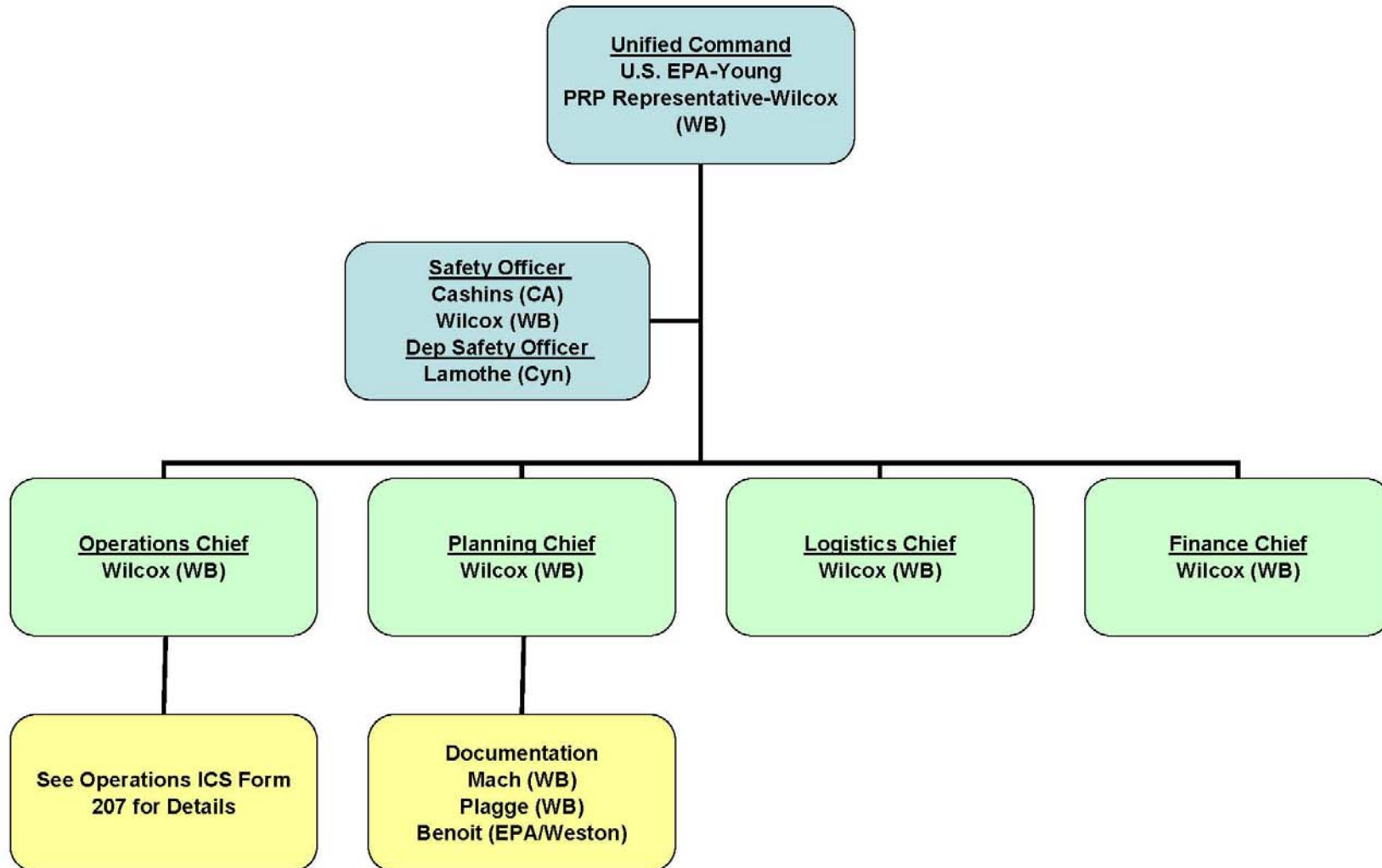

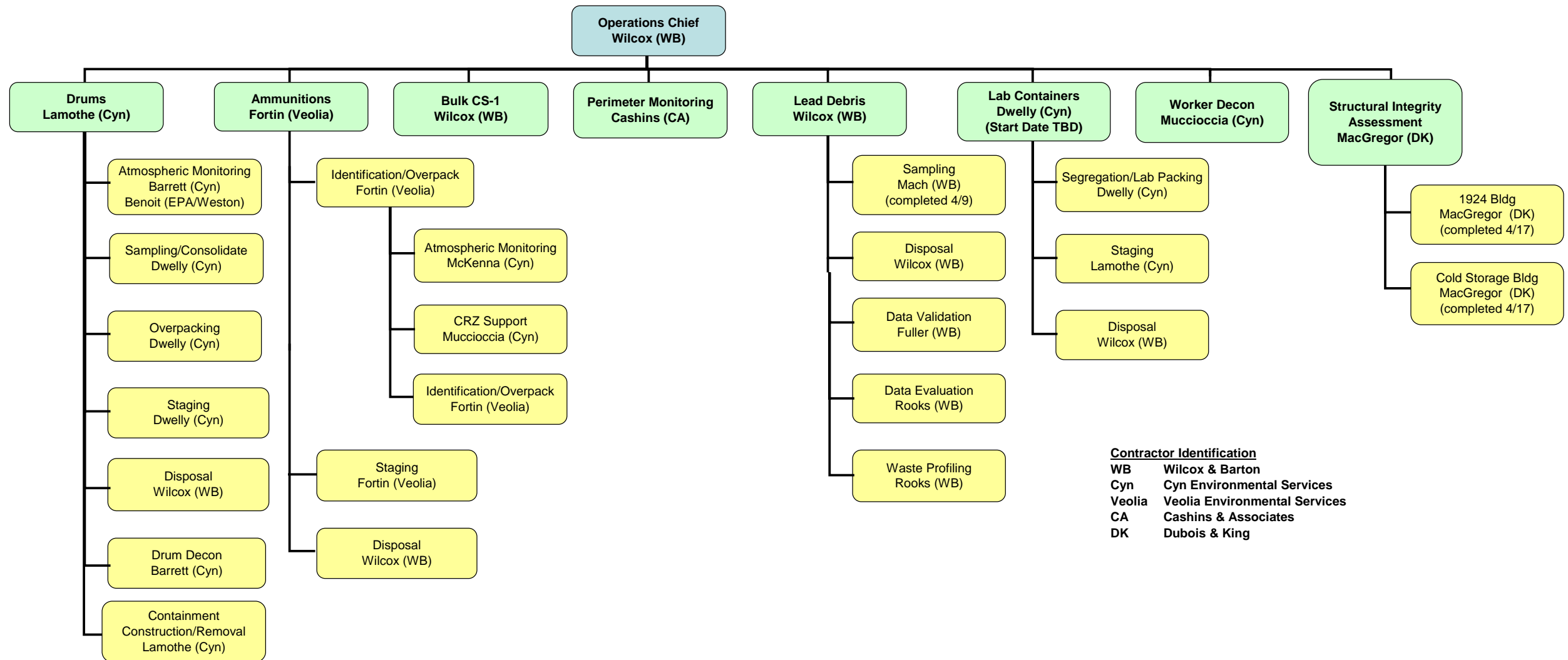

Collect samples of drums requiring further analysis for disposal determination. 4. Repackage and dispose of all waste material located in the 1924 and Cold Storage buildings. 5. Coordinate with appropriate Federal, State and Local emergency planning agencies regarding resale or transfer of bulk CS-1 material from the mill to an appropriate off-site location. 6. Coordinate with appropriate Federal, State and Local agencies regarding the removal action and local emergency planning actions.

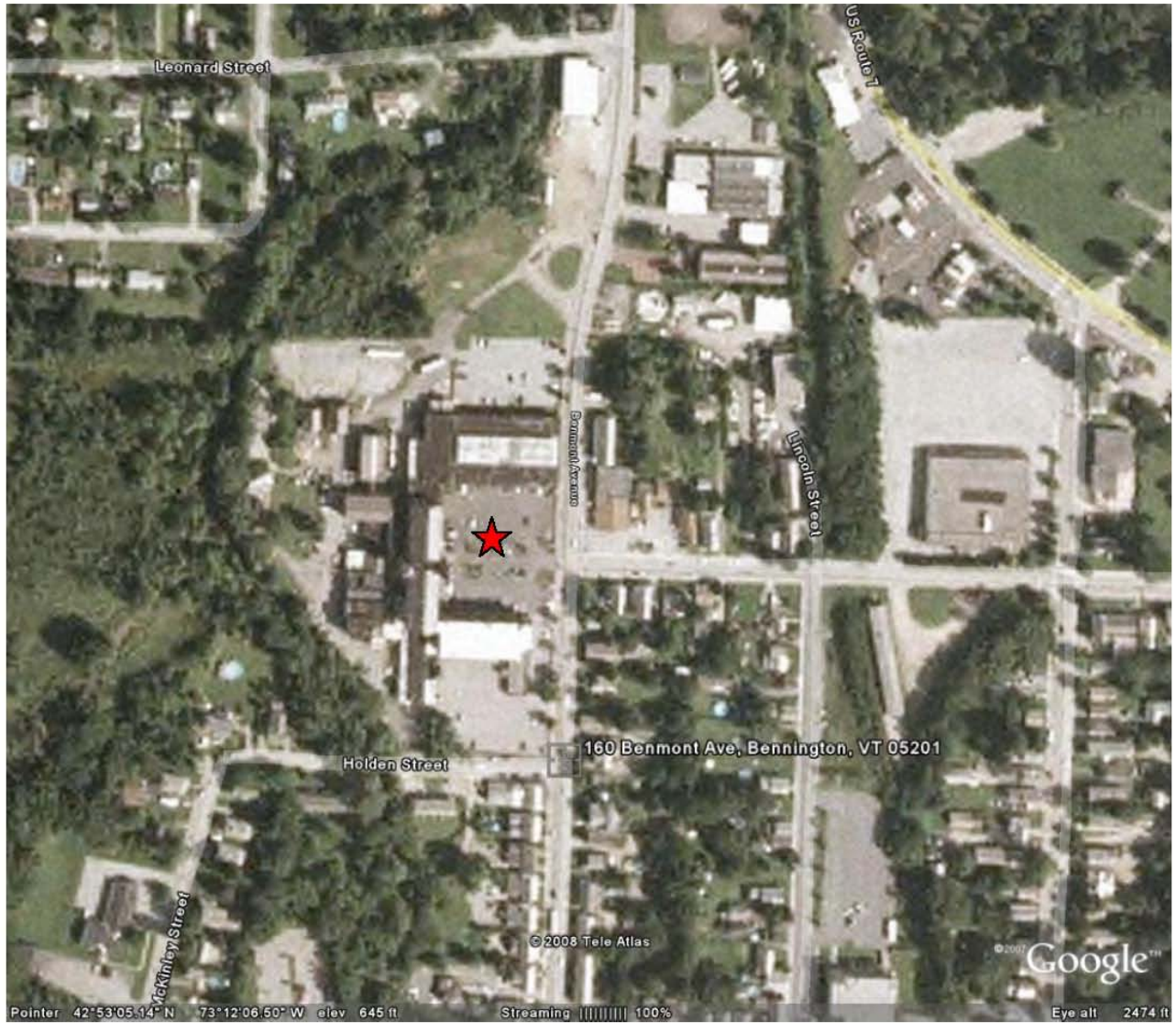

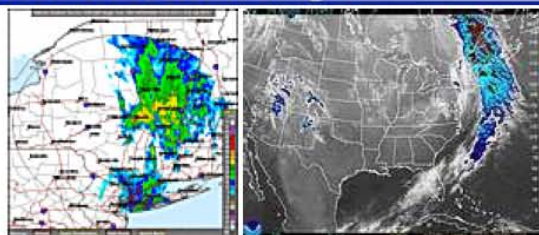
