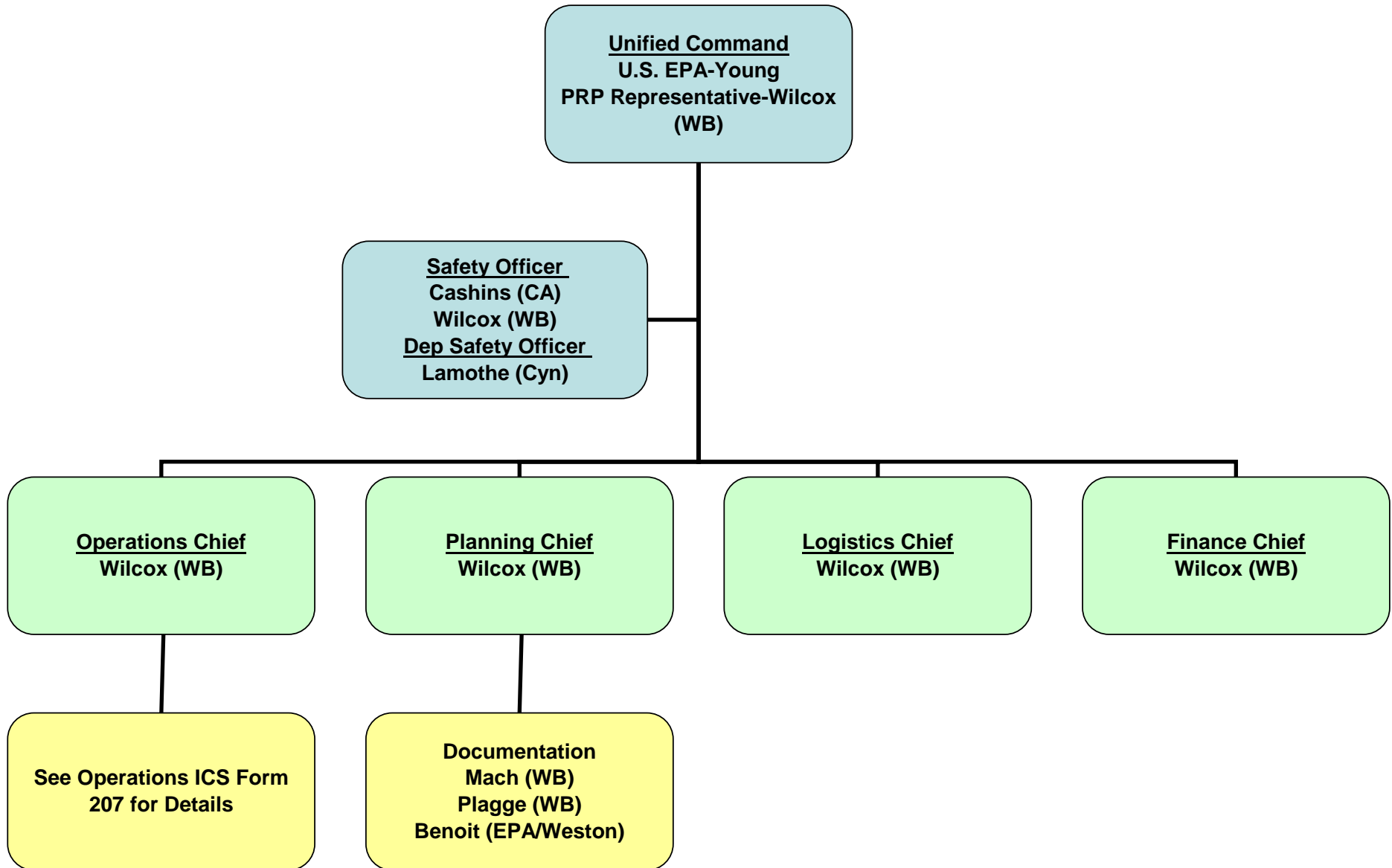

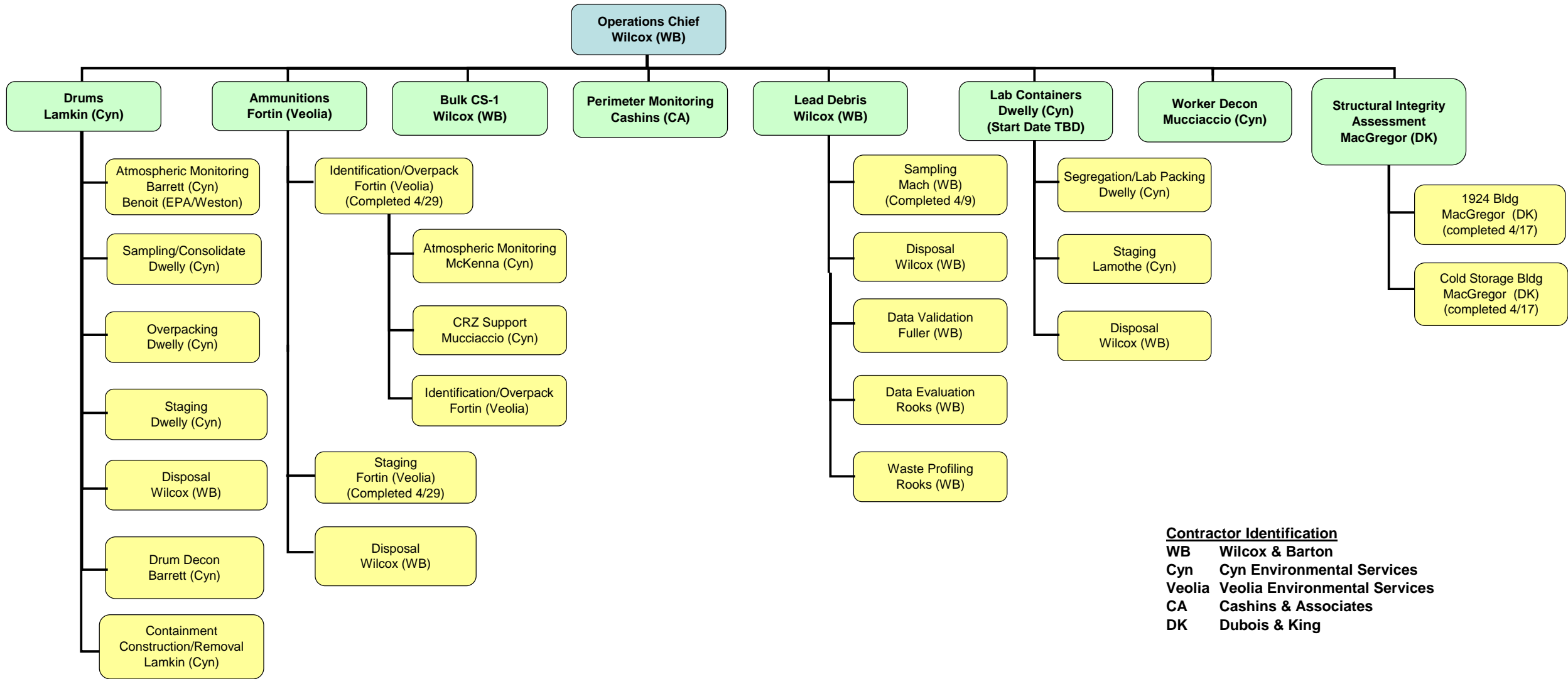

<b>3. Incident Objective(s)</b>  1. Ensure safety of the public and workers while conducting removal activities in accordance with the site-specific work plan and health and safety plan.  2. Assess drums, containers and ammunitions located in the 1924 building, cold storage building, Pellet room, and other areas of the mill for repackaging and storage in the first floor of the 1924 building.  3. Collect samples of drums requiring further analysis for disposal determination.  4. Repackage and dispose of all waste material located in the 1924 and Cold Storage buildings.  5. Coordinate with appropriate Federal, State and Local emergency planning agencies regarding resale or transfer of bulk CS-1 material from the mill to an appropriate off-site location.  6. Coordinate with appropriate Federal, State and Local agencies regarding the removal action and local emergency planning actions.

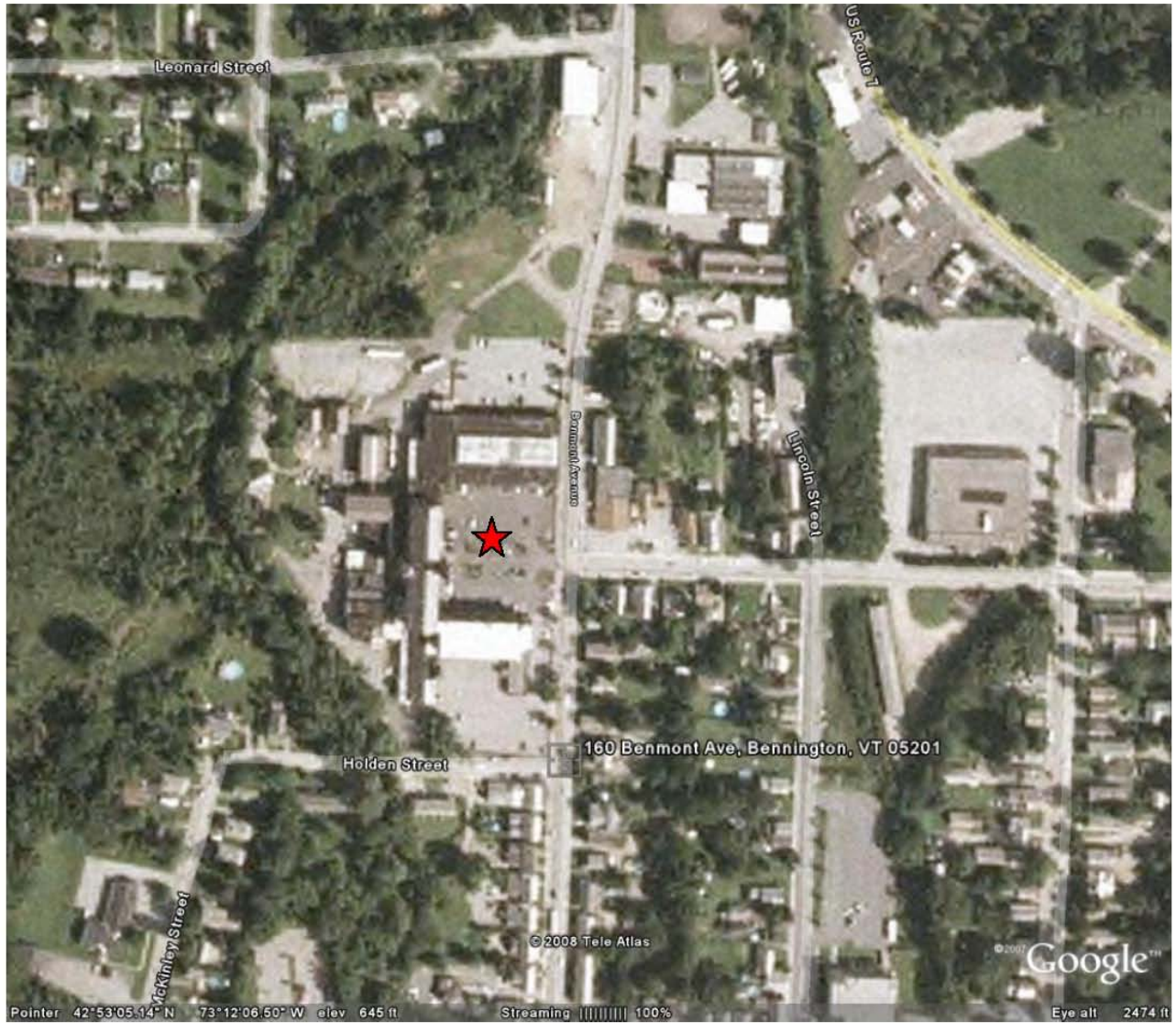
