

Memo to Adjust Guidelines for Work-Rest Period

Protection Levels – Heat Exposure

Moran Health and Safety Plan - Section 4.2.1

In addition to all listed precautions for Heat Stress the following changes are made to the Site Specific Health and Safety Plan for the Kidney Center of Savannah (SG1533).

In the event that the body temperature, measured orally or through the ear canal, reaches a level of 101.6 (One Hundred One point Six) the worker will be transported to the closest medical facility in operation for assessment and treatment as deemed necessary by the attending physician.

In the event that the body temperature, measured orally or through the ear canal, reaches a level of 100.4 (One Hundred point Four) and remains at that level for longer than 15 (Fifteen) minutes the worker will be transported to the closest medical facility in operation for assessment and treatment as deemed necessary by the attending physician.
