TWO TAR PONDS ARE DISCHARGING TAR THROUGH THE BANKS OF THE PONDS. THE TAR IS MOVING NORTH AND HAS BUILT UP BESIDE THE RAIL ROAD TRACKS. IT THEN TRAVELS THROUGH A CULVERT UNDER THE RAIL ROAD TRACKS AND IS MOVING TOWARDS BLACK WARRIOR RIVER. IT IS APPROXIMATELY 150-200 YARDS AWAY FROM THE RIVER.
