DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT

CALLER STATES THEIR SOUR WATER TANK AND TWO SUB-CONTRACTED 1,500
GALLON VACUUM TRUCKS CAUGHT ON FIRE POSSIBLY DUE TO A "BACK-FLASH"

THAT OCCURRED WITH A NEARBY TRUCK WHILE IT WAS OPERATING. THE TWO VACUUM TRUCKS BELONG TO A COMPANY CALLED "RECLAMATION RESOURCES" AND ONE OF THE DIESEL TANKS MAY HAVE RUPTURED BUT ALL THE FUEL BURNED UP WITHIN THE FIRE. CALLER STATES THEIR SOUR WATER TANK WAS EMPTY BUT THERE WAS ABOUT 1 FOOT OF RESIDUAL HYDROCARBON LEFT IN THE TANK AND BASED OFF THE PARTICULAR PRODUCT (CALLED CALPAR 40) THEY ESTIMATE 50 POUNDS OF SULFUR DIOXIDE AND 50 POUNDS OF HYDROCARBONS WAS BURNED IN THE FIRE.
