Dear Mr. Kahn:

The purpose of this correspondence is to address the issues in the above-captioned Field Notice issued to Abrachem Chemical ("Abrachem") on October 30, 2008, and to outline Abrachem's activities and schedule relating to the removal of containers stored in the intermodal shipping containers ("ISC").

Foremost, the one leaky drum, subject of the response inspection, has been over-packed and containerized and placed within the warehouse facility (secondarily contained).

Next, all ISC containers will be secured and inventoried – cross referencing all hazardous and non-hazardous materials therein. As applicable, all materials and containers will be labeled and segregated for removal either by Abrachem or client/customer. Any unidentifiable material will be characterized and field tested and disposed of (where necessary) pursuant to applicable regulations by Abrachem's environmental consultant GTI.

Abrachem will complete the removal of fifty percent of the inventory and chemicals on hand by November 15, 2008. The remainder of all chemicals and inventory will be removed by December 25, 2008.
