Here is what we have so far. All four samples that we ran for Glycol show peaks at the same retention time. This chromatogram shows that the Pond, Man-hole, Emerson Sumps have characteristics that match. Is this Hexylene Glycol? We have to run a standard to be sure and the vendor can not get it to us until tomorrow.

Meanwhile...we will continue to work on this incident in the other areas. Hopefully we can show agreement in all of the tests that we run.
